

Intermediate (Grade 7/8) Volleyball Information 2021 Coaches' Checklist

- All participants and all volunteers (coaches, referees, scorekeepers, etc.) must be fully vaccinated. The process for students who wish to participate but are not yet fully vaccinated is outlined at the bottom.
- In person practices can begin for students who are fully vaccinated and students that are 14 days past their first dose with rapid testing.
- Verify vaccine information (visual verification of second dose vaccination receipt, no information is to be collected or copied) prior to the start of any practices.
- Keep daily attendance records of practices and games and forward those records to school administration for contact tracing purposes.
- If you are a community Coach/Volunteer - you need to show visual proof of full vaccination and a completed Vulnerable Sector Screening before working with the team.
- Hand out and collect all completed FORMS before any team practices/ games begin - [Interschool Athletics Consent Form](#) and [Volunteer Driver Form](#)
- A note for Parents/Guardians regarding volunteer drivers: *"Given the ongoing risk of COVID-19, the LDSCB (or "the Board") will not be responsible for the transportation of students to/from activities. The Board is not in a position to confirm the vaccination status of volunteer drivers. For this reason, you are encouraged to drive your own family members to/from activities. Should you choose to carpool with another family, please note that you are doing so at your own risk. Confirming the vaccination status of drivers and the wearing of masks in the vehicle are strongly recommended. "*

- Important changes/updates to rules:
 - Masks are to be worn by all participants and volunteers at all times (as per [Ophea/OPASSE Guidelines for Interschool Athletics](#)).
 - No spectators allowed.
 - The focus of the 2021 season is on a safe return to play and skill development. There will be no scores submitted this season and no playoffs.

The process for students who wish to participate in Elementary Interschool Athletics and who are not yet fully vaccinated is as follows:

- Students must have one dose of a vaccine and wait 14 days prior to participation.
- Students must complete and pass the daily COVID-19 School Screening Tool <https://covid19.ontario.ca/school-screening/>
- Students must take a rapid test for COVID-19 twice a week with three days in between each test to be eligible to continue participating.
- The rapid test schedule should be Sunday and Wednesday so that visual verification may occur on Monday and Thursday prior to participation.
- Visual verification must be confirmed by school staff.
- Families are responsible for obtaining rapid tests.
- Once the second dose is received, the student must show visual confirmation to school.

***The process will only be available until November 30th, 2021.**
